1. **About TTSP**

2. **TTSP's Privacy Statement**

- **Nature of information collected**

- **Purposes**
TTSP or third parties on its behalf, may use the personal information that you provide:
 - to process and respond to your questions and/or inquiries, and

 - to provide you with any TTSP services and products.
 - to keep and maintain its user records and share with government agency and authorities.

TTSP, or third parties on its behalf, may also use certain information you provide in an aggregate and anonymous form for internal business and planning purposes, such as statistics.

- **Security**
Protecting your privacy and your information is a priority at TTSP. TTSP has taken reasonable measures to protect your personal information from loss, misuse and alteration. However, please be aware that no data transmission over the internet or storage technology can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. TTSP can only take steps to help reduce the risks of unauthorized access.
